Overview, Target Audience and Learner Outcome

This conference is for interdisciplinary healthcare team members caring for pediatric patients in the emergency and pre-hospital setting. As a result of this session, learners will be able report new knowledge related to pediatric specialty practice in order to provide current, evidence-based practice care to pediatric populations.

Objectives

- Discuss critical care components in pediatric cardiac arrest in the context of recent recommendations made by the AHA and the debate surrounding these recommendations.
- Discuss the presentation and management of several disease processes seen in children requiring the PICU.
- Describe an NRP- based approach to emergencies in the immediate neonatal period, including updates from NRP 8.
- Review and compare the various mechanisms (burn,friction,explosive) and management (surgical and non-surgical) of pediatric hand and finger injuries.
- Identify best practices related to care of the pediatric patient experiencing a mental health emergency including suicidal ideation.
- Discuss a multidisciplinary approach for best possible trauma outcomes through a case study.
- Identify the priorities in the initial management of the injured child.
