## Overview, Target Audience and Learner Outcome

This activity is for the interdisciplinary healthcare team will include a review of current literature and clinical pathways followed by Children's Hospital Colorado for the evaluation, treatment and management of emergent neonatal care. In addition to a presentation from a content expert, attendees will participate in case study review and discussion to provide direction on clinical practice. As a result of this activity, learners will be able to self-report new knowledge related to recognition and resuscitation of neonates during emergencies.

- Describe neonatal resuscitation goals including ventilation, thermoregulation and delayed cord clamping
