Overview

This course is designed for pediatric surgeons, urologists, gynecologists and gastroenterologists, as well as advanced practice providers and pediatric nurses managing patients with colorectal and urogenital conditions. This course will show three live operative demonstrations (one per day), what we believe are the most important surgical/technical maneuvers to be performed during the repair of anorectal malformations.

Objectives

- Review the principles of diagnosis and management of anorectal malformations
- Recognize the importance of multi-disciplinary care when treating these patients
- Discuss the challenges of short-and long-term postoperative care
- · Recognize indications for reoperative surgery
- Discuss management of associated urologic and gynecologic problems
- Review the comprehensive management approach to cloacal exstrophy
- Outline the use of the posterior sagittal approach for a variety of conditions
- Differentiate, treat, and manage fecal incontinence and constipation

Learner Outcome

After attending this event, participants will report increased knowledge of pertinent clinical conditions of pediatric patients with a colorectal malformation.

This three-day intensive teaching course will examine the surgical treatment and management of pediatric colorectal and urogenital surgical problems including:

- · Live operating room demonstrations with discussion
- Methods of evaluation of pre-operative imaging
- · Anorectal malformations
- Cloacal malformations
- · Cloacal exstrophy
- · Urology and gynecology management
- Prognosis of these deformities
- · Idiopathic constipation
- · Fecal incontinence
- · Transition of care
- Psychosocial support
