This conference will emphasize an integrated approach to care among family, community, and healthcare teams through case-based presentations, and thought-provoking discussions.

Target audience includes: Pediatric nurses, advanced practice providers, therapists, social workers, mental health counselors, care coordinators, case managers, child care providers, teachers and others assisting children and their families with healthcare needs in hospital, ambulatory, telephone triage, community health, public health, school, child care, and home settings.

9. Demonstrate skills related to students with tracheostomies, gastrostomies, and catheters in a school setting.
