3rd Annual Jason French Pediatric Hospital Medicine Virtual Symposium

Overview and Target Audience

The Jason French Pediatric Hospital Medicine Symposium is to commemorate the life and service of our colleague, Jason French, who tragically passed away in the summer of 2020. Dr. French was a beloved member of the Section of Pediatric Hospital Medicine at Children's Hospital Colorado and served on the planning committee for this conference.

This conference is designed for all health care professionals who participate in the care and management of hospitalized children and neonates. A case-based format will be used to review and discuss the etiology, diagnosis, and management of critically ill infants and children. After attending this symposium, the participant will report an increase in knowledge related to the hospitalized pediatric and neonatal patient and increased confidence caring for the pediatric patient population in the rural hospital setting.

Learning Objectives

- Review frequently heard questions and clear up common confusions that arise from both old school and cuttingedge diagnostic tests for infections in children.
- Review the current guidelines regarding the management of Pediatric DKA as well as an update on known complications that occur during treatment.
- Explore intersections between pediatric mental health and hospital medicine.
- Interpret and manage CBC results.
- Define surgical co-management and discuss the creation of a surgical co-management team at Children's Hospital Colorado (CHCO), including its benefits, challenges, and future aspirations.
- Analyze and discuss interesting pediatric patient cases.
- Examine social media/digital platforms, clinical decision support tools, AI, multiomics and precision medicine focused on Neonatal care.
