Virtual Education Series: Ready or Not Here I Come: Stabilization of Newborns Prior to Transport

Overview, Target Audience and Learner Outcome

This activity for the interdisciplinary healthcare team will include a review of current literature and clinical pathways followed by Children's Hospital Colorado for newborn resuscitation and stabilization. In addition to a presentation from content experts, attendees will participate in case study review and discussion to provide direction on practice. As a result of this activity, learners will be able to report new knowledge related to newborn stabilization in order to provide current, evidence-based care to neonatal patients.

Objectives

- Review the programs available to teach the initial steps of neonatal resuscitation and stabilization.
- Identify common conditions associated with newborn infants requiring transfer to a higher level of care.
- Describe the interventions and supplies to maintain stabilization of the newborn while awaiting transport to a higher level of care.
