Overview, Target Audience and Learner Outcome

Each 2026 Target Zero Forum presentation will provide data, examine actual CHCO safety events, and explore best practices and cause analysis for CHCO employees, faculty, fellows and residents. As a result of this series, learners will report increased knowledge on safe practices and reducing preventable harm in an ever-changing healthcare environment. Participants will report at least one practice change they intend to make as a result of this education.
