Pediatric Emergency Education Lecture Series: Let's All Take a Deep Breath Now

Overview, Target Audience and Learner Outcome

This activity for the interdisciplinary healthcare team will include a review of current literature for the evaluation, treatment and management of pediatric patients encountered in the prehospital or emergency setting. EMS Providers and nurses working in the prehospital or emergency setting will benefit from this education. As a result of this activity, learners will be able to report new knowledge related to the evaluation, treatment, and management of pediatric patients in prehospital and emergency settings across a variety of emergency conditions.

Objectives

1. Identify risk factors associated with non-accidental trauma (NAT) in pediatric patients to support early recognition and appropriate clinical response.
2. Describe evidence-based therapeutic goals for traumatic brain injury (TBI) and apply lung-protective ventilation strategies to optimize patient outcomes in critically ill infants and children.
3. Examine anatomical and physiological differences in infants with chronic lung disease and integrate these considerations into respiratory management.
