Overview, Target Audience and Learner Outcome

This activity for sonographers and other interested healthcare team members will include pediatric scanning techniques, cardiac structures of interest, and neonatal echo emergencies. In addition to a presentation from content experts, attendees will participate in case study review and discussion to provide direction on clinical practice.
