- Identify common causes of and treatment options for pediatric respiratory distress.
- Discuss best practices for communicating about vaccines with hesitant parents.
- Describe the current usage trends of youth and digital technology and correlations with mental health.
- Recognize pediatric cardiogenic shock and identify initial management strategies.
- Review pediatric septic shock with emphasis on essential diagnostics and clinical interventions.
